Site: Inglis Barracks, Mill Hill, NW7

Proposal: Outline application for the comprehensive redevelopment of the site for a residential mixed use development including provision of 2,174 dwellings, a primary school, GP practice, 'high street', employment uses, district energy centre and open space.

I am writing to you regarding the planning application for the above proposed development. As you may be aware, last year the Council adopted an Area Action Plan (AAP) for Mill Hill East which details how the area should be redeveloped. Inglis Consortium held an exhibition in February 2009 outlining their proposals for part of this area. Following the feedback from the exhibition they revised their proposals and these were recently submitted in the form of a planning application for part of the site. In November 2009 we wrote to residents asking for comments on the application.

In addition to this we would now like to invite you to attend a public meeting at **Frith Manor Primary School, Lullington Garth on 2nd February 2010, between 7.00pm and 9.30pm so you can have the opportunity to ask any questions about the application.**

Inglis Consortium, will give a presentation of the proposals at 7.30pm on the night. Copies of the plans will be available to look at on the day and representatives from Inglis Consortium and the Council will be present to answer any questions you may have.
